

Pineville Pre-Season Wee Ball Tournament

Thank you for participating in the Pineville Pre-Season Wee Ball tournament. The following rules will help this event run smoothly.

- Admission: Adults and 13 up -- \$5
12 & Under - Free
- Coaches & wives enter free (limit 3)
- Games will consist of 2 innings or a 55 minute time limit, whichever comes first. After time has expired, the batter may finish his/her bat and the game will be over
- The pitcher, catcher, on-deck batter, and all base runners must wear a protective helmet, equipped with a face guard
- A 10' circle defines the minimum distance a ball must travel to be "live and in play" (on the line is considered a live ball)
- The batter is allowed three swings to hit the ball and then a coach must assist them in hitting.
- Balls hit to the infield will result in 1 base for the batter. Balls hit to the outfield can be a double, triple or a homerun. Once the ball gets back inside the 10' home circle the runners get the next base and must stop.
- The catcher may go outside the 10' circle to make a play on a live ball. No defensive player other than the catcher may enter the 10 foot circle
- The batting lineup will consist of the entire roster
- The team that is batting may have a coach at first base, second base, and third base to assist the runners
- No head first slides

Pineville Pre-Season Wee Ball Tournament (continued)

- The entire team will play the field (6 players on infield); all remaining players will play behind the infield/outfield line
- The team that is fielding may have 2 coaches in the outfield to assist the fielders
- The Wee Ball league should teach our children how to run, throw, catch, and bat. The PYBSA discourages a fielder from running across the field to make an out, when the normal play would be to throw the ball.
- Remember there is No score kept.
- Please remember - the purpose of a Dixie Youth Wee Ball program is to instruct boys and girls in the following areas:
 1. Principles of good sportsmanship and fair play
 2. Basic fundamentals of baseball and its rules
 3. Team participation
 4. How to win humbly and lose gracefully
 5. Playing safe
